## REYMAN E MAIL REPORT

Hello from rainy, cloudy and cool Alberton, South Africa. We pray that each of you will celebrate the resurrection of our Lord this weekend. This is Karen updating you on the ministries in which we are involved.

### **MINISTER'S WEEK**

Paul attended Minister's Week in early March for three days and preached on Wednesday evening for the banquet. This year it was held in Humansdorp in southeastern South Africa. Phoebe Rees attended also and sold teaching materials from the Gospel Resource Centre.

### **SAMARITAN COMMUNITY CARE/TIGANE CHURCH OF CHRIST**

Paul travelled to Tigane, about a two and a half hour drive, on Wednesday, 9 March, to attend a feeding of the Samaritan Community Care. More than 95 children were fed. Paul and Patson Phiri, the minister, went to Klerksdorp to the council offices to check on the progress of approval for a plot that the church can build on. The plot had been approved for "alienation" by the Mayoral committee. The required fees were paid and now the alienation process has begun i.e., advertisement in the paper, measuring and valuing the plot, etc. The official said he thought it would take about two months for the process. We can hope that is true, but this is Africa!

### **WORK PERMIT**

We arrived in South Africa four years ago this month. It is time to renew our work permit and Paul took the application paperwork to immigration today, the 23rd. Please pray with us that the application will be accepted.

### **YOUTH CAMP**

Next week we will travel to the Drakensburgs Mountains for a youth camp with the youth from the Northside Christian Church. Brion and Joyce Morris, the ministers/missionaries there, and eight of the youth are planning to go. We pray it will be a time of good fellowship and teaching.

## **UNDER HIS WINGS CHOIR**

On 5 March the choir that I direct sang the "worship event" *Jesus, the One and Only* at Berea Christian Tabernacle. The choir sang well, but the attendance was disappointing.

We were invited to a primary school for their Easter assembly and fourteen members of the choir were able to go. We were amazed at the good behaviour of the six hundred children and their enjoyment of the drama before we sang and then during our three songs selected from *Jesus, the One and Only*. When one thinks about the refusal of the USA schools to even allow a prayer in school, then it is truly amazing that they would allow a drama about the gospel story and our songs about Jesus.

## **Quilting Class at Ellerine's Community Development Centre**

The first quilting class for the year was held on Thursday, 10 March, at the Ellerine's Community Development Centre in Germiston. Two other ladies from our quilter's group helped with the twenty ladies that attended. We teach them sewing and quilting skills so they can make items to sell and improve their income. Most of the ladies are from a squatter camp. We meet each Thursday afternoon.
